



REGULATIONS

1.
11/22, the International Comedy Short Film Festival, will take place in Vienna (Austria) from June 16th to June 20th, 2009.
2.
The festival consists of two international competitions:
Category 11: for all films up to max. 11:59 min. of total runtime (including credits)
Category 22: for all films between 12 up to max. 22 min of total runtime (including credits)

In each category the winner will receive the 11/22-trophy and EUR 1.122,- prize money.
Possible additional awards will be announced on the festival website www.11-22.at .
All awards will be given to the director of the film.
3.
Permitted are all narrative film- and video-productions (fiction and animation – no documentaries), that tell their story by means of satire, slapstick, grotesqueness, skit, black humour, running gags, absurd, surprising punchlines, etc.
4.
The film has to be presented in German or English or be provided with subtitles in one of these two languages.
5.
Submitted films have to be completed after January 1st, 2006 and are not allowed to be shown neither on one of the other Viennese film festivals (Vienna Independent Shorts, Ohne Kohle, Viennale etc.) nor on Austrian TV nor in Austrian cinemas before 11/22 will take place.
6.
Allowed to submit is any natural person, production company or institute of film and cinematography, that disposes of all required rights for participation in the festival and public screening of the film. Each participant may submit more than one film.
7.
Submitted films may be screened more than once at the festival and can be used for promotional screenings of the festival also.

8.

The film has to be sent on DVD in PAL (region 0 or 2) together with the duly completed and signed entry form to the festival.

The DVD has to be labelled with the title and the exact runtime of the film.
Every submitted film must be recorded on a separate DVD (without menu).

9.

Submission is free of charge.

10.

Submitted films must be received by **March 2nd, 2009**.

(Late Deadline **only** via withoutabox: **March 30th, 2009**)

Submissions from Non-EU-countries must be labelled "No Commercial Value / For Festival Only". If there is a declaration of value to be given, the declared value has to be less than EUR 10,-. All postal costs have to be paid by the participant.

The filmmakers will be informed about the decisions of the jury by May 2nd, 2009 via e-mail.
A catalogue of the selected films will be available on the festival-homepage www.11-22.at.
The decision of the jury is definite. Legal recourse is excluded.

12.

By the jury selected films cannot be withdrawn from the festival.

The submitters of the selected films pledge themselves to send the following documents:
photo of the director and stills (format JPEG, 300dpi), synopsis, short biography and filmography of the director (via email); if available: film posters, press kit, flyer etc. (via snailmail).

A second DVD in best quality (without menu) may be requested from the festival.

13.

Submitted DVDs and documents will not be returned and stay in the festival's archive.

14.

The festival may use sequences up to 10% of total runtime, as well as all logos, photos and texts on purpose of promotion on TV, radio, cinema, internet and in print media exempt from charges.

Nominated and awarded films may be presented in full length on the festival collection DVD.

15.

By submitting a film the participant accepts all regulations.

The festival administration shall decide all cases not covered by these regulations.
